- ✓ We will not engage in or support the use of corporal punishment, mental or physical coercion, and verbal abuse
- ✓ We will comply with applicable laws and industry standards on working hours
- ✓ We will ensure that salaries paid will always meet legal or industry minimum standards
- ✓ We will not knowingly engage in business associated with any activity that is corrupt
 or contravenes moral, legal or social codes of practice
- ✓ We will operate to the highest standards of ethics and respect the cultural diversity of the markets in which we operate

- ✓ We will comply with the applicable environmental laws and regulations in the territories within which you operate
- ✓ We will possess all the necessary environmental permits and registrations
- ✓ We will strive to minimize relevant environmental impacts
